#### PDMP MANDATORY QUERY ACT



#### PDMP MANDATORY QUERY ACT

- Prescribers with a DC license are required to query the DC PDMP prior to initiating a new course of treatment for a patient in DC that includes prescribing an <u>opioid</u> or <u>benzodiazepine</u> for more than 7 consecutive days, and every 90 days thereafter while the course of treatment or therapy continues.
- Effective from March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021



#### PDMP MANDATORY QUERY ACT

- **Dispensers** with a DC license are required to query the DC PDMP prior to dispensing an **opioid** or benzodiazepine for a course of treatment that is anticipated to last for more than 7 consecutive days, and before dispensing a refill for an opioid or benzodiazepine more than 90 days after the initial fill or previous fill date.
- Effective from March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021



#### **MANDATORY QUERY ACT – EXCEPTIONS**

- Does not apply if the patient:
  - Is currently receiving hospice or palliative care
  - Receives the medication during an inpatient hospital admission or at discharge
  - Is in a nursing home or residential care facility that uses a sole source pharmacy
- PDMP is not operational/available due to a temporary technological or electrical failure, emergency, or natural disaster, in which case the Prescriber or Dispenser must document the circumstances in the patient's medical record

- Partial Spelling: Using Partial Spelling can be helpful for hyphenated or commonly abbreviated names (Will vs. William). At a minimum, enter the first three characters of the patient's first and/or last name.
- Prescription Fill Dates The maximum time period for your search is 3 years
- PMP Interconnect Search allows you to search other participating state databases for the patient's records.
- To improve the likelihood of finding a specific patient:
  - For out-of-state searches Limit your search criteria to only the required fields.
  - For in-state searches In addition to the required fields, include additional details such as ZIP code.

#### MANDATORY QUERY FAQ'S

- Is there a record of each PDMP query?
  - Yes, each query to the PDMP is recorded within the database and includes details pertaining to who performed the query and when
- Does a query still count even if no information is returned?
  - Yes
- What can I do if I notice a discrepancy in a patient's PDMP history?
  - Contact the dispensing pharmacy if a discrepancy is found
  - Discrepancies can be corrected by the pharmacy that submitted the dispensation data



#### **PDMP DELEGATES**



Licensed, registered, or certified by a health occupations board
 employed at the same location and under the direct supervision of the prescriber or dispenser

Complete the application (must be co-signed by supervising prescriber or dispenser)
 Send the application + a copy of government issued ID to <u>doh.pdmp@dc.gov</u>
 Create a PDMP account at <u>http://districtofcolumbia.pmpaware.net</u>

- Registration for delegates expire June 30<sup>th</sup> of every even-numbered year
- If the delegate becomes ineligible, the program must be notified in writing within 24 hours (email <u>doh.pdmp@dc.gov</u>)

<u>NarxCare</u> The NarxCare platform allows providers and dispensers to view patient health history and patient risk scores. NarxCare's analytics tools help providers and dispensers make decisions to increase patient safety and reduce the risk of prescription drug misuse and overdose.

<u>Gateway Integration</u> The DC PDMP provides the option to all Health Care Entities (HCE) in the District of Columbia to integrate DC PDMP data into their clinical workflow. DC Health covers the licensing fees associated with the integration service for every health care entity in the District of Columbia that elects to connect its Electronic Health Records (EHR), Health Information Exchange (HIE), or Pharmacy Dispensing System to the PMP Gateway.

<u>PDMP Advisory Committee</u> The DC PDMP Advisory Comittee is a multisector committee made up of 7 members. The committee's goal is to make recommendations to DC Health's director regarding PDMP best practice, regulatory and legislative updates, education and outreach to prescribers and dispensers, and program enhancements.
