# March Monthly Meeting: CBCT: Diagnosis and Treatment in the 3rd Dimension

The Surgical Operating Microscope was the singular greatest influence in the practice of endodontics in the last decade. The year 2008 heralded the implementation of Cone Beam Computed Tomography into the endodontic armamentarium and, more specifically, the introduction of small-volume scanning technology. This 21st century version of the SOM allows for diagnosis and treatment planning in three dimensions, and for the opportunity to perform "virtual surgery" in those instances where it is questionable whether or not a "conservative" approach to treatment is appropriate. This presentation highlights the science and principles of CBCT/CBVT, and demonstrates, using case studies, how integral this has become to the delivery of exceptional endodontic care.

Dr. Niemczyk received his dental degree from the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine in 1982 and his postgraduate endodontic certificate in 1984. Since 1995 Dr. Niemczyk has been the director of endodontic microsurgery at Harvard University in Boston, MA and Albert Einstein Medical Center in Philadelphia, PA. He maintains a full time practice limited to endodontics in Drexel Hill, PA.



### **2012 Nation's Capital Dental Meeting**


